Special permission is required if you wish to bring in your own musicians or your own officiant.

Costs associated with funeral services:

UCW catering: \$10 per person. This includes food and use of the hall.

Minister: \$200

Organist: \$100

Use of Hall without UCW catering: \$25 per hour
